

## **Summer Reading Assignment Instructions**

**8<sup>th</sup> Grade: *White Fang***

***By: Jack London***

***Students should read the novel, and write a 4-5-page report. The report is due on the first day of school.***

The 4-5 page report needs to include each of the the following items:

1. A list of characters (only list them by name)
2. In at least a half-page, describe the following:
  - a. Characters (Choose 3-5 main characters)
  - b. Plot (summarize briefly)
  - c. Setting (Time)
  - d. Setting (Place)
  - e. Conflict and Resolution
3. Briefly explain how you were able to identify the setting. What are some events that are happening during the course of the story in the wider world?
4. Write a summary (half-page or less) on what you liked most about the book.
5. Write a summary (half-page or less) on what you liked least about the book.
6. Write 1 paragraph for each of the following:
  - a. What happened at the beginning of the story?
  - b. What happened in the middle of the story?
  - c. What happened at the end of the story?

All the above should be in a 4-5 page report. Break it down how you see fit, the best way to make sure that all the work is balanced out.
