St. Hilary Catholic School uses the California State Standards for the curriculum, as mandated by the Archdiocese of Los Angeles.

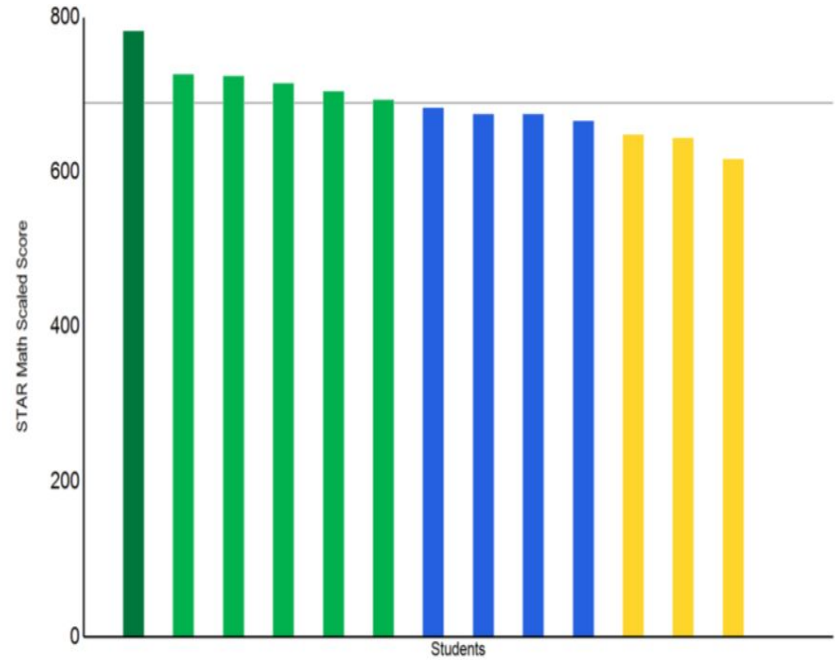
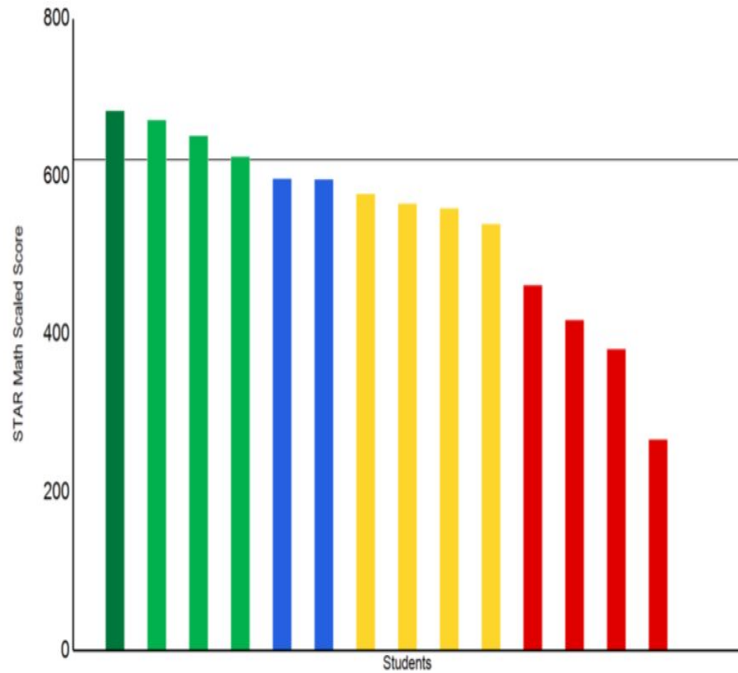

 - If each family commits to selling 4 tickets, we will raise over **\$10,000, plus the bonus!!!**

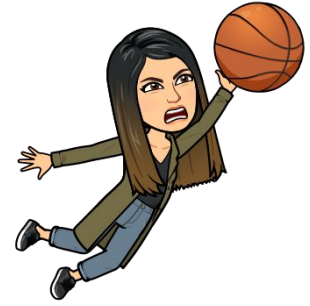
SCRIP PROGRAM
